Keep in mind that nearly everything in Pittsburgh is connected by the "T". You can literally go from Mt. Lebanon to Station Square to Mt. Washington (via the incline) to Market Square to the Golden Triangle/Gateway Center to the North Shore (PNC Park) and back without having to get in a car.
